verification, subject to accountability and transparency, subject to any openness of the decision making process. They would operate in over 3,000 secretive working groups. Those non-elected or accountable bureaucrats would have a monopoly to originate and pass laws without any voter participation or say. They would constitute an army of 30,000 highly paid officials whose loyalty would be with the Union created and not the country of origin. Their number including all the technical and support staff would add up to some 170,000. That of course is only the legislative part of the government - the Commission headed by a former Maoist Communist. The two other branches of Bogota government would have their own armies of Bureaucrats. Incidentally no system of checks and balances would exist between the legislative, judicial and executive branch. Due to their number, not efficiency, they would produce laws faster than rabbits can multiply and those laws would initially number 20,000 laws contained in over 100,000 pages of legal documents, whereas no books would be available where a law on any specific subject could be found. Those laws would regulate the official, acceptable maximum curvature a banana may have, the ingredients permissible in a yogurt, cereal or a local specialty, say the New York Pizza, to call them so and all such other vital aspects of your life. Taxes would be uniform and hover around 50% or more. Your local courts would enforce Union laws with the understanding that the Bogota courts are superior and can overturn any verdict. New Constitution would consist of 505 pages (US Constitution is now some 13 pages long!) that could not be read without a lawyer and even that would not guarantee, one would actually understand it. Am I exaggerating, not in the least! The presented short description is the reality of the EU today, enhanced with the consequences, implementation of the Lisbon Treaty will bring. New EU would be irreversible and non-reformable by its citizens. All this however is only the tip of the iceberg. Oh did I mention the folks ruling in Bogota would not only be hostile to Christianity, they would be Christianophobic!

Polish Sejm (Lower House of the Parliament) signed its recommendation to ratify the Lisbon Treaty by the President on April 1, 2008 at 17:17 (5:17 pm). Allegedly April 1 is traditionally associated in the Catholic Church as the day ascribed to Judas Iscariot, a day more widely known as April Fool's Day. More telling however, is the time 17:17. Why would that even be an issue you may ask? Well for once, since one rarely ever sees specific time given in the media, when a legislation or recommendation is passed. In this instance it was! In fact last time I remember this specific time given in the media 17:17, was the day after assassination attempt on John Paul II. L'Osservatore Romano, the official Vatican paper gave the time as 17:19 which is the time, it really happened. Aside from L'Osservatore Romano, all papers worldwide gave the assassination time as 17:17. What is the significance of 17:17 or rather 1717 you may ask. 1717 is the year when three Masonic Lodges of the Scottish rite unified in England and it is accepted as the birth date of Contemporary Free Masonry and used within their symbolic as a recognizable trademark of sorts. The problem is, they do not have a clue what the Lisbon Treaty is all about and if they do, they cannot do anything about it! It started as the European Constitution, - the New Project Europe. The European Constitution contained in 560 pages of text was subjected to voter verification and presented to the citizens of France and Netherlands in separate referendums of May and June 2005. On both counts it was voted down. People did not want it. Embarrassed Brussels political elites understood that it would never pass in referendums. They took out the newly adopted anthem (Beethoven's 9th Symphony's Ode to Joy) and the 12 stars of David on a blue background - EU official flag, scrambled the very same text to be illegible without a lawyer and completely beyond comprehension by regular mortals, named it the Lisbon Treaty and required it to be adopted by all Member States by acts of their National Parliaments. No full, comprehensive text of the Lisbon Treaty was to be available in the national languages of the Member States until ratified by their Parliaments. No referendum was to be held, but in Ireland, since Irish Constitution required a national referendum to any changes made thereto. Brussels offered substantial funds to secure a "yes" vote. Since the very goal of the Lisbon Treaty was, to be accepted by EU citizens without being understood what its effects would be, its purpose was to conceal and deceive. Let me quote the Belgian Foreign Minister, Karel de Gucht: "The Constitutional Treaty was to be more readable. The aim of this Treaty is to be unreadable. The Constitution aimed to be clear, whereas the Treaty had to be unclear. It is a success!" The former French President, V. Giscard d'Estaing was even more candid and said, I quote: "Public opinion will be led to adopt, without knowing it, the policies we would never dare present to them directly. All the earlier proposals (from the democratically rejected Constitution) will be in the new text (the Lisbon Treaty) but will be hidden or disguised in some way."

With millions of Euros available from the EU and support from the prominent "The Irish Times" with their editor Geraldine Kennedy spearheading the "yes" vote, the Irish government was confident they would deliver. God only knows, how it would have turned out, if it were not for a man of Providence, Mr. Declan Ganley, a very talented, eloquent and articulate proud Irishman, an entrepreneur and self-made millionaire who entered the scene and was able to mobilize the Irish to actually read the Lisbon Treaty copy he provided. He distributed it through Libertas a Pan-European party he created to bring democracy to the EU and make it accountable to its citizens. He successfully engaged the Irish to get acquainted with the Treaty provisions and sparked a debate that despite a rage filled smear campaign that was thrown at him, managed to persuade his compatriots to take notice and think. The Irish did just that, they overwhelmingly rejected the Lisbon Treaty with their "NO" vote. What was presented to them was no more than the EU Constitution the French and Dutch rejected in 2005 just in a separate envelope (image used by President V. Giscard d'Estaing). Many of those in Europe, that had wished for a referendum, celebrated with great joy. The EU Bureaucracy could not believe what has happened and reacted with fury. The Irish were chastised and humiliated across Europe by the Lisbon Treaty proponents. According to the rules, that the presently binding Treaty of Nice defined, requiring

unanimity of all 27 Member States, the Lisbon Treaty was dead. But Brussels decided to change the rules of the game while the game was on. For them it was far from dead. The Irish Cowen-led government immediately indicated that reversal of the decision will be attempted through another referendum. In general it was implied to go ahead with ratification elsewhere, because Ireland will eventually ratify! Pressure on Polish President was mounting and a Danny Cohn-Bandit dominated delegation committed a frontal assault on Czech president Vaclav Klaus to force his signature, causing an international scandal through threatening and complete lack of respect or manners towards their host or dignity of office and country he represented! Mr. Declan Ganley on the other hand, had received two serious and specific death threats.

Libertas the Pan-European party Mr. Ganley created took part in the June 6th 2009 European Parliamentary elections and lost across the board. There are many reasons why this has happened, but media assaults all across Europe to crash Libertas, ad hominem attacks on Mr. Ganley, which among others implied he was an American agent and was financed by the American government, advertising his supposed unlimited fortune, a multi-millionaire image that was not accurate but very counterproductive when it came to fund-raising, all took their toll. Mounting a major Pan-European party and initiative that aspired to turn Brussels upside down within as short a time as was available and funds as scarce as they were, was too much to handle even for a man as unique and talented as Mr. Ganley. Political fund-raising attitudes differ greatly to those in America. Unreasonable assumptions outside Ireland, that if he supported something and had the resources, he should finance it all himself, are not only ridiculous, since those in whose interests he acted, should show willingness to share the financial burden. Besides it would be illegal.

New Irish referendum scheduled for October 2, 2009, will decide the fate of not only Ireland, but all of Europe. The battle for Poland has thus shifted to the Emerald Island. The Irish vote is of paramount importance. The result far from certain. On the one hand the EU Bureaucracy is well aware that if the Irish vote "NO" again, the game is over. If the Lisbon Treaty gets derailed they will have to come up with something sensible or foil their USSR re-run ambitions. In this battle timing is everything. Germany is running out of money to finance the game and may not be able to sustain it much longer. Interestingly enough, German equivalent of the Supreme Court recently ruled, that the Lisbon Treaty is compatible with the German Constitution, provided the Constitution gets amended to include the provision that any EU law will be binding for Germany if it gets accepted by the German Parliament. This amendment in effect, due to a loophole left in the Treaty, that no other country can now utilize, will leave Germany as the only country that can opt out of any EU law it chooses not to adopt.

Ireland was and is subjected to extensive and immense pressure. Guilt feeling on the one hand, for all the

prosperity the EU has allegedly brought Ireland since its 1973 accession, which in part is true, but ignoring Irish own contribution in political and economic wisdom, talent and hard work. On the other hand, it is plain and simple - fear. French President Nicolas Sarkozy came shortly after the first "NO" vote, threatening that Ireland will not get a penny from the EU if it votes "NO" again. This message has been pounded into Irish ears with great persistence and force. It would not go well with the Irish, if it were not for the great economic slump, in part the fault of the worldwide economic crisis that the US ignited, in part due to inaction or failed economic policies of the present unpopular government, who let down their citizen by not better protecting them from dire consequences of failures of the finance and real estate sectors and the economic downturn. Visiting Ireland I heard over and over, that FEAR is what may bring about the "yes" vote. That includes the fear I heard expressed on occasions that the referendum may be rigged. People in those uncertain times fear for their livelihood and this is the hot button that is being used to twist arms. It seems, it is more vengeance the Irish fear than being cut off from illusory financial help the EU could provide, since in today's EU, the "Each for himself" rule applies and the so called European Solidarity was never more than an empty phrase (the Russian Federation Polish meat embargo, Baltic Sea gas pipe bypassing Poland, Russian gas supply politics, destruction of Polish Ship Yards to eliminate competition to German and French Ship Yards, etc.). The German Chancellor Angela Merkel threatened she will not shake hands with anyone opposed to the Lisbon Treaty.

Fear thus, is what is prevalent and together with deception and lies is the foundation upon which "New Europe" is being build. Millions of Dollars have been designated by the EU to win the Irish "yes" vote. No money is available on the "NO" side. Mr. Ganley is left to foot the bills from the Libertas campaign and without major contributions is unable to run another "NO" campaign.

Especially susceptible to aggressive and well financed "yes" propaganda, is the young swing voter who wants "Change", but lacks the political savvy and understanding of the effect the Lisbon Treaty will bring. Change is not necessarily always a good thing, as those of us who voted the "Change" candidate in the recent U.S. elections, are slowly beginning to realize. Change to make sense must be for the better. Incidentally observing Europe we would be well served to keep a watchful eye on our own backyard. Socialism is a disease no less deadly than Nazism (National Socialism).

Will the Irish withstand the pressure? EU offered them additional bogus guarantees that will not stand to legal challenge. Will they have enough wisdom and stamina to say "Thank You but NO" to this gigantic shameless FRAUD shoved down people's throats against their will? Time will tell. For the sake of the Irish, Poland and the rest of Europe, much prayer is needed and a lot of money. □
